



International Air Law Moot Court Summary Rules and Procedures

The International Air Law Moot Court Competition, a joint initiative of the Sarin Memorial Legal Aid Foundation, India, and the International Institute of Air and Space Law (IIASL) of Leiden University, the Netherlands is open to teams composed of two to three students enrolled in Law Schools, Law Faculties or Law Departments. The 2011 edition is held in cooperation with the Civil Aviation Authority in Dubai, United Arab Emirates.

Each institution is allowed to participate with one team. Participating students may be enrolled in LL.M. programmes. Doctoral students are excluded from participation.

Each team shall have a Faculty Adviser.

Each team must submit memorials for both the Applicant and the Respondent.

The Oral argumentation will take place between 12-15 March 2011 in Dubai.

The Board of Review scoring the briefs and the Semi-Finals panels will be composed of leading authorities in the field of air law. The Final Bench will be composed of the most prominent experts in this field.

The costs of participation are borne by the participating teams. There is no additional registration fee. During the Semi-Finals and Finals in Dubai certain events will be sponsored.
